

My son has a near fatal drowning when he was 2 years old. Since then he has been terrified of water. At times it has been a struggle to even give him a bath. He swims, he actually swims. On a recent school field trip to an aquatic center his teacher told me that they had a hard time getting him out of the pool, he was just having too much fun to leave. This truly brought tears to my eyes. In the past he would have sat on the edge and just watched while other kids had fun or I would have taken the day off work so he didn't have to go. I really can't thank you enough for all that you have done for him. I am eternally grateful for the confident little boy who not only loves the water but also the little boy who feels safe in it.
